DIFFERENTIATE:

- Older kids may prefer to produce a podcast or you tube episode, sharing whatever they are most interested in right now.
- Younger kids may feel more confident doing something more familiar, like singing a nursery rhyme with actions or props

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Get a large cardboard box
2. Cut a hole in the front of the box, leaving the bottom attached so you can use it as a show surface
3. Use teddies/ Lego people / wooden dolls, or if you're feeling more adventurous, make your own puppets from felt or paper)
4. Act out a favorite book or TV episode, or create your own story

EXTEND:

- Design tickets and posters advertising your show
- Use your box for other adventures!(ours became a spaceship complete with bottom launch pad and pipe cleaner handles)

ALTERNATIVE RESOURCES:

No Box? No problem!
