SPY SCHOOL; LASER LABYRINTH



DIFFERENTIATE:

- For younger kids, reduce the risk of trips by using tape stuck to the floor, for them to jump and step over
- Increase the challenge by adding items to the string that will make a noise if disturbed or implement a count down timer for them to race

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Choose your space, Pick a room, or garden area with objects to tie string between; chairs, tables, trees,
2. Grab your materials. You'll need:
 - a. String, ribbon, or yarn (red is perfect for the "laser" look!),
 - b. Tape or scissors if tying is tricky
3. Create your laser maze
 - a. Tie or tape the string across the space at different heights and angles.
 - b. Criss-cross it, zig-zag it, loop it—make it look tricky but possible! Leave just enough room to crawl under, step over, or stretch around.

EXTEND:

- Increase the fun by introducing challenges;
 - retrieve an object from the centre of the maze
 - incognito mode - no talking (or giggling)
 - team building mode, one agent gives directions to another blindfolded agent

ALTERNATIVE RESOURCES:

- To add to the experience you could;
 - get the kids to make and signs (warning, danger,)
 - use a timer or countdown to increase suspense
 - play some spy music
